Response to Intervention: (RtI)

Use assessment data and teacher feedback to help support students that are showing signs of struggle.

When students score at the 34%ile or below on assessment data, we will discuss Math or Reading support. We will contact parents about this as needed.

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports: **PBIS**

Recognize and encourage good behavior

Put safeguards in place for students that show signs of struggle: (Adult Mentors, Structured Resource, Small Group re-teaching)

Communicate building and classroom expectations

Social and Emotional Learning Standards are addressed through the Advisory Curriculum called Second Step.
