Math

- My Math is only a RESOURCE that we will use to meet the standards. We will continue to supplement the My Math series as needed to assist our students in meeting the demands of the Common Core State Standards.

Math

- There will be various websites that each teacher is using, such as Front Row, Power My Learning, and Prodigy, that reinforce skills taught. There will be times when students will be directly assigned to access these sites for homework, but they can be accessed at any time.
