<u>Kindergarten Registration</u>: If you have a child who will turn five years old on or before September 1, 2018, please take note of the following information. Millburn District will be accepting registration for kindergarten on Wednesday, April 4, 2018 from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at Millburn Elementary School, 18550 Millburn Road, Wadsworth. ALL registrations will be accepted at Millburn Elementary School. You must call the school to request a registration packet. Millburn Elementary's main office phone number is 847-356-8331.

If you know anyone in our district who may not receive this notification, please ask them to contact the school. We appreciate your help as we prepare for the next school year!

FIRST GRADE - if you have a child enrolled in a kindergarten program other than the Millburn District, please notify the office if you intend on registering your child for First Grade in Millburn. Your child must be six years old on or before September 1, 2017 to register for the first grade in this district.

<u>Caps and Lids Updates</u>: We will continue to collect caps and lids (remember PLASTIC only) until <u>FEBRUARY 28.</u> At that point we should have at least 1000 #s to purchase 3 benches: 1 - 8 ft. rainbow bench and 2 - 4 ft. benches.

<u>Winter Assessments</u>: Over the next few weeks, we will be doing assessments to check-in on the progress of all of our students.

In Kindergarten, students will again be administered the Aimsweb assessment. This is a 1:1 administered test where each child sits down with a staff member to assess literacy and numeracy skills.

In Grades 1st-5th, the STAR assessment will be given. This computer-based assessment allowed us see student growth since Fall, and individualises the test based on their skills. The reports allow our teachers to plan their instruction to insure students are challenged throughout the year.
