<u>Kindergarten Registration</u>: If you have a child who will turn five years old on or before September 1, 2018, please take note of the following information. Millburn District will be accepting registration for kindergarten on Wednesday, April 4, 2018 from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at Millburn Elementary School, 18550 Millburn Road, Wadsworth. ALL registrations will be accepted at Millburn Elementary School. You must call the school to request a registration packet. Millburn Elementary's main office phone number is 847-356-8331.

If you know anyone in our district who may not receive this notification, please ask them to contact the school. We appreciate your help as we prepare for the next school year!

FIRST GRADE - if you have a child enrolled in a kindergarten program other than the Millburn District, please notify the office if you intend on registering your child for First Grade in Millburn. Your child must be six years old on or before September 1, 2018 to register for the first grade in this district.

<u>Valentine's Day Parties:</u> V-Day parties will be Friday, February 9<sup>th</sup> at 1:00. The PTO is working hard to get all the activities ready to go for our students. We do want to remind families that our holiday parties are **FOOD-FREE**. Do not send Valentine's Day cards that include candy such as NERDs boxes, FunDips, Candy heart boxes, etc. Also, do not send goodie bags filled with food items. Our holiday parties are designed for fun without the need for treats or goodie bags. There is no need to send anything that day with your child, except Valentine's Day cards for their fellow students. Any candy or goodie bags brought in will not be distributed to students and will be sent home with the child or parent who brought them. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

<u>Double Lunches</u>: Some of our older students occasionally take double lunches, which we do allow. Yet, we have encountered situations where parents are not aware their child is taking double lunches until they are notified their lunch ticket is depleted.

If you encounter this situation with your child, please talk with them to assure they do not take double lunches. With 715 students, we cannot monitor all requests for student to not take double lunches. Thanks for your assistance!

<u>Caps and Lids Updates:</u> We will continue to collect caps and lids (remember PLASTIC only) until <u>FEBRUARY 28.</u> At that point we should have at least 1000 #s to purchase 3 benches: 1 - 8 ft. rainbow bench and 2 - 4 ft. benches.
