Dismissal Changes for Students: There are times that your child may have a change in their dismissal procedures. We understand that happens on occasion. To make sure changes are properly communicated to not only the teacher, but to the office as well, we ask for parents to do the follow in the event of a dismissal change.

- 1) Reach out to the teacher **and** to Ms. Sooley (rsooley@millburn24.net) via email/note, or phone call about the change *prior* to the school day starting.
- 2) If the change is made once the school day begins, contact the office only. Teachers have such a busy day and although they check emails on a regular basis, there might be a time they get caught up and may not check before dismissal time.
- 3) No need to send a note if you are picking your child early from MBAC. No matter what, you are picking the child up from there. The teacher nor the office needs to know about early pick-up from MBAC. Contact us only if they are not to go to MBAC.

Bottom line, the office always needs to know of changes to assure that is communicated to teachers prior to dismissal.

Spelling City: For many of our teachers, Spelling City has been a widely-used resource for our students to practice their spelling words. Although the website offers fun ways for students to learn have, we have discovered that Spelling City displays inappropriate ads. We have seen ads for games which involve shooting and killing.

We want to provide a safe and appropriate learning experience for our students. Therefore, Millburn School will no longer be using Spelling City effective December 22. Parents are welcome to continue to use the site if they so choose, but the school will no longer be using it as a resource for students.

We wish the website didn't have these adds and I know this is unfortunate news for many of you. However, this is a necessary step. If there are changes to the site that we feel is more appropriate in nature, we will reconsider this decision..

This is a good time to review the content we view on the web. Many times we are oblivious to the ads that pop up on the side of the screen, but they just might be inappropriate in nature. Monitor the best you can when you child is certain sites or using certain applications. We may not be able to control what pops up, but we can control where they go.

Yearbooks: Yearbook ordering countdown is on! Place your order by January 7, 2018 to receive a yearbook for your child. The basic yearbook is currently \$18.00 and will increase to \$25.00 on January 8, 2018.
