I want to take this time to wish everyone a relaxing and fun winter break. I have been extremely proud of all our Mustangs this first half of the school year. It is great to see students excited about learning and I have seen some great things coming from them. Use the next two weeks to rest up because we expect more excitement and hard work when we return in 2018!

I also want to keep you updated on our curriculum. As I mentioned at Parent Night, we are exploring new Social Studies, Science, and English Language Arts curriculums. Currently, we are piloting Mystery Science in all K-5 classrooms. So far the reviews have been great not only from our teachers, but our students as well. We will continue to use Mystery Science this year and determine if this will be our future science curriculum.

We also are exploring Social Studies curriculums. Studies Weekly is what we are currently piloting in 6 of our classrooms K-5. Right now it is too early to tell how we like this program. We will continue to pilot Studies Weekly and review if the programs fits our needs.

In addition, we have begun looking at reading curriculums. It was 2008 when we last adopted a reading series. We have talked with local school districts in the county and had a number of companies show us programs to consider. Reading is a cornerstone to a child's learning, therefore, we will be very careful when choosing a program. We want a program that is not only rigorous for our students, but engaging as well. We would like to have the new program for next year, but in all reality, it may not be until the 2019-2020 school year.

Finally, we continue to work on updating our report card. Our first steps were to create Power Standards for both Math and English/Language Arts. When developing Power Standards, we are analyzing all the common core standards and then combining and prioritizing the essential skills we want students to master. It is our intention that the Power Standards will be the basis for our future report card. This fall, grade level teams developed Math Power Standards. Our next step is looking at ELA and developing Power Standards in that area. We are still shooting at 2019-2020 to roll out the new report card for grades K-5.

Again, have a wonderful winter break and I look forward to seeing everyone in January!

<u>Dismissal Changes for Students:</u> There are times that your child may have a change in their dismissal procedures. We understand that happens on occasion. To make sure changes are properly communicated to not only the teacher, but to the office as well, we ask for parents to do the follow in the event of a dismissal change.

- 1) Reach out to the teacher <u>and</u> to Ms. Sooley (rsooley@millburn24.net) via email/note, or phone call about the change *prior* to the school day starting.
- 2) If the change is made once the school day begins, contact the office only. Teachers have such a busy day and although they check emails on a regular basis, there might be a time they get caught up and may not check before dismissal time.
- 3) No need to send a note if you are picking your child early from MBAC. No matter what, you are picking the child up from there. The teacher nor the office needs to know about early pick-up from MBAC. Contact us only if they are not to go to MBAC.

Bottom line, the office always needs to know of changes to assure that is communicated to teachers prior to dismissal.

<u>Yearbooks:</u> Yearbook ordering countdown is on! Place your order by January 7, 2018 to receive a yearbook for your child. The basic yearbook is currently \$18.00 and will increase to \$25.00 on January 8, 2018.

When prompted, put in the following code: 4190018. Please make sure you are entering orders for year Millburn Elementary. You can find the name in the upper left hand corner.

If you are ordering for both schools you will need to enter the orders under separate codes.

Read to Succeed: The Six Flags Read to Succeed program has begun! Every student who completes six hours of reading (outside of school) before February 23, 2018 is eligible for a free admission ticket to Great America! In addition, a season pass upgrade offer is available during the ticket valid dates. The upgrade offer information will be printed on the ticket, which your child will receive at the end of the school year. (Valid dates are typically between June and August. In the past, the season ticket upgrade has been offered for \$30.) In order to participate, please print a student reading log (located in the Millburn virtual backpack), record the reading your child does at home, sign the reading log, and submit the completed reading log to your child's classroom teacher by February 23rd.
