<u>Illinois School Report Card</u>: The Illinois Report Card is an annual report released by the Illinois State Board of Education that shows how the state, and each school and district, are progressing on a wide range of educational goals. The Report Card was redesigned in 2013 to be more user-friendly and to provide data on a wider range of indicators than previous versions. The Report Card now offers a more complete picture of student and school performance in order to inform and empower families and communities as they support their local schools.

We are very excited to see that our students have made huge strides in their overall performance over the last few years in Literacy and Math. We want this trend to continue, yet focus on closing gaps in some of our subgroups, specially discrepancies with males and females and our low-income students I encourage you to visit the website and review our information.
