<u>Flu Season-</u> Wow, this has been a tough year with many still struggling thru the flu and illness. We think we have it beat and then it comes back again. <u>PAYING BY CHECK?</u>- New banking regulations are enforcing the "Payable to" name on checks that are deposited to the Millburn bank accounts. <u>ALL</u> checks that are written out to the schools for lunch, field trips, activities, MBAC, etc. etc., MUST now be made payable to "Millburn School District 24." If made out differently, they will have to be returned for correction before being able to be processed. Tedious, we know so your efforts are appreciated!

<u>Kindergarten Registration</u>: If you have a child who will turn five years old on or before September 1, 2018, please take note of the following information. Millburn District will be accepting registration for kindergarten on Wednesday, April 4, 2018 from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at Millburn Elementary School, 18550 Millburn Road, Wadsworth. ALL registrations will be accepted at Millburn Elementary School. You must call the school to request a registration packet. Millburn Elementary main office phone number is 847-356-8331.

If you know anyone in our district who may not receive this notification, please ask them to contact the school. We appreciate your help as we prepare for the next school year!

FIRST GRADE - if you have a child enrolled in a kindergarten program other than the Millburn District, please notify the office if you intend on registering your child for First Grade in Millburn. Your child must be six years old on or before September 1, 2018 to register for the first grade in this district.

Read to Succeed: The Six Flags Read to Succeed program will be coming to an end later this month, but there is still time to get reading logs in by Friday, February 23rd! Students can earn a FREE ticket to Great America by reading for six hours, completing a reading log, and turning it into their classroom teacher by February 23rd. In the past years, free ticket holders have also been able to upgrade to a season pass for just \$30. Reading logs can be downloaded and printed from the virtual backpack on the Millburn website. <u>PARCC</u> <u>Testing:</u> PARCC, our state assessment, is approaching, it is roughly 8 weeks away. This assessment will be administered to students in grades 3rd-5th. Students will be taking 7 tests total (4 Math, 3 English/Language Arts). This year, students will be taking <u>two</u> <u>tests</u> <u>in</u> <u>a</u> <u>day</u> to decrease our number of testing days and minimise impact on instruction.
