<u>PARCC Testing:</u> Our students did great with PARCC testing this week. This was the first time we did it on iPads and it worked well. Thank you for your help in making sure iPads were charged each night! We are very proud of our Mighty Mustangs, well done.

<u>Illinois Science Assessment:</u> All fifth- and eighth-graders and some high school students will begin taking the Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) THIS SPRING. The ISA aligns with our new <u>Illinois Learning Standards</u> in science. This assessment helps families understand how well students are performing academically and see whether they are on track to succeed in college. The ISA represents Illinois' commitment to preparing all students for college and careers, including in the high-demand science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields. The assessment also satisfies federal accountability requirements. 5^{TH} Graders at MES will take their assessment on Wednesday, April 25th. The assessment should last about 45 minutes. You will find a parent letter about this assessment in this week's virtual backpack.

<u>Coins for the Community:</u> The Student Council would like to thank everyone who donated coins for our community service officers. Together we collected 3,826 coins! Our total collection was \$316.45! The money will be able to buy a few nice meals for our local police officers and firefighters. Thank you Mustangs!

<u>2018-2019 Class Placements:</u> We are currently in the process of planning and placing students into homerooms for next year. Please find a letter in the Virtual Backpack with some information on how this process works. As a reminder, class lists WILL NOT be sent via email over the summer. Parents will need to log into PowerSchool to see their child's homeroom teacher once it goes live in August. Parents are encouraged to set up their accounts ASAP to access before the next school year begins. <u>PARTy Day (PBIS)</u>: Throughout the year, we have planned celebrations for our students known as PARTy Days (play on words....Do Your PART). These days are designed to celebrate the positive choices our students make throughout the year. Each grade level plans fun activities for students as part of the celebration. The grade level with the lowest percentage of students with minors/majors get PARTy Day with Mr. Rowlands and I. We are very proud of our students as currently over 90% have received 0-1 minor/major this school year. There are times that some students make a bad choice, but learn from the mistake. On rare occasions, students may repeat behaviors or chronically display inappropriate choices over the course of time. We plan to use PARTy Days as a reteaching opportunity for these students that need more support. They will get to participate in our school-wide celebration, but we want to use part of the time to reinforce skills.

Our next PARTy Day will be Friday, April 27th from 1-2. Great job to our Millburn Mustangs for DOING THEIR PART!

For PICK UP, please pull in and find a parking spot. You can meet your child at the canopy area. You can also use the pick up lane, but if everyone does this, the line of traffic will stretch out to Route 45! No students will be allowed to walk or ride a bike home.
