<u>Lockdown Drill:</u> Today we conducted a lockdown drill with our students. This drill is designed to secure our students and staff in a safe location in the event of an intruder coming into the building. We emphasized with students to always follow the direction of their teacher and, when a lockdown drill is called, to locate the first available classroom to go into. Students did a great job with this drill.

We understand this is a difficult topic to discuss. Our number one goal is the safety of our students and we always want to be prepared for situations, no matter how small the probability may be.

<u>Water Issues:</u> Millburn Elementary have been dealing with water issues. Over Spring Break, we had work done on our well to help improve sediment that was coming in with the water. We still continue to battle sediment coming in. These issues are only occurring on the west side of the building (Grades KDG, 1st, 4th, and 5th). Our maintenance staff flushed out the pipes in the sinks to eliminate the occasional grayish appearance. The drinking water has been tested and it is safe to drink, but it does smell bad. Water stations have been setup to provide drinking water for students

The lunch changes this week were not due to this issues. The water heated in our kicthen went out and our food management couldn't make their scheduled meals due to this issue.

<u>Millburn Garden:</u> It is that time of year to request a plot in the Millburn School and Community Garden. Requests for plots can be made by emailing the membership coordinator, Samantha Hutchinson at samanthakayhutchinson@gmail.com no later than May 15th. There are large plots (12X20) for a \$50 fee and small plots (5X20) for a \$25 fee. Plots are based on availability and garden participation. The goal of the garden is to provide an area where citizens, students, faculty and families can grow fresh produce, flowers and herbs for their enjoyment.

5th Grade Invited to Millburn Middle School: Attention all 5th grade parents and students!! On Tuesday, May 1st, you are invited to come to the Middle School to see the building, meet some of the teachers, and find out a few exciting things to look forward to when you are a 6th grader. <u>Moving from Millburn?</u>: We are already gearing for next school year. Currently, we are preparing registration packets to send home to families. If you and your family are planning on moving before next school year, please let us know so we know not to send home a packet.

<u>Illinois Science Assessment:</u> All fifth- and eighth-graders and some high school students will begin taking the Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) next Wednesday. The ISA aligns with our new <u>Illinois Learning Standards</u> in science. This assessment helps families understand how well students are performing academically and see whether they are on track to succeed in college. The ISA represents Illinois' commitment to preparing all students for college and careers, including in the high-demand science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields. The assessment also satisfies federal accountability requirements. 5^{TH} Graders at MES will take their assessment on Wednesday, April 25th. The assessment should last about 45 minutes. You will find a parent letter about this assessment in this week's virtual backpack.

<u>2018-2019 Class Placements:</u> We are currently in the process of planning and placing students into homerooms for next year. Please find a letter in the Virtual Backpack with some information on how this process works. As a reminder, class lists WILL NOT be sent via email over the summer. Parents will need to log into PowerSchool to see their child's homeroom teacher once it goes live in August. Parents are encouraged to set up their accounts ASAP to access before the next school year begins. If you need assistance with getting your account set-up, there is a help sheet in the Virtual Backpack.

We are very proud of our students as currently over 90% have received 0-1 minor/major this school year. There are times that some students make a bad choice, but learn from the mistake. On rare occasions, students may repeat behaviors or chronically display inappropriate choices over the course of time. We plan to use PARTy Days as a reteaching opportunity for these students that need more support. They will get to participate in our school-wide celebration, but we want to use part of the time to reinforce skills.
