<u>Kindergarten Registration</u>: Did you miss Kindergarten registration on Wednesday? Don't worry, you can still come in and turn in your paperwork. If you still need a registration packet, you must call the school to request a packet. Millburn Elementary main office phone number is 847-356-8331. Our office hours are from 8-3:30 Monday-Friday.

<u>PARCC Testing:</u> PARCC, our state assessment, is NEXT WEEK. This assessment will be administered to students in grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>. Students will be taking 7 tests total (4 Math, 3 English/Language Arts). This year, students will be taking <u>two tests in a day</u> to decrease our number of testing days and minimise impact on instruction. Testing will take place April 9th-12th. Since students will be taking the assessments on their iPads, it is very important that they bring them each day, *fully charged*. If students do forget their device or do not have a fully charged device, they may need to make-up a test another day.

Headphones are needed for all ELA units. Students are required to have headphones at school. The headphone plug-in must be checked in advance to fit into the ipad through the opening of the ipad case. To help ensure assessment security guidelines are met, wireless headphones are not permitted.

Students are urged to get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast prior to testing. If students arrive late to school, they will not be allowed in their classrooms until the testing session is completed. Additionally, a make-up session would be required.

<u>Illinois Science Assessment:</u> All fifth- and eighth-graders and some high school students will begin taking the Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) THIS SPRING. The ISA aligns with our new <u>Illinois Learning Standards</u> in science. This assessment helps families understand how well students are performing academically and see whether they are on track to succeed in college. The ISA represents Illinois' commitment to preparing all students for college and careers, including in the high-demand science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields. The assessment also satisfies federal accountability requirements.  $5^{TH}$  Graders at MES will take their assessment on Wednesday, April 25. The assessment should last about 45 minutes. You will find a parent letter about this assessment in this week's virtual backpack.

<u>2018-2019 Class Placements:</u> We are currently in the process of planning and placing students into homerooms for next year. Please find a letter in the Virtual Backpack with some information on how this process works. As a reminder, class lists WILL NOT be sent via email over the summer. Parents will need to

log into PowerSchool to see their child's homeroom teacher once it goes live in August. Parents are encouraged to set up their accounts ASAP to access before the next school year begins. If you need assistance with getting your account set-up, there is a help sheet in the Virtual Backpack.

These days are designed to celebrate the positive choices our students make throughout the year. Each grade level plans fun activities for students as part of the celebration. The grade level with the lowest percentage of students with minors/majors get PARTy Day with Mr. Rowlands and I. We are very proud of our students as currently over 90% have received 0-1 minor/major this school year. There are times that some students make a bad choice, but learn from the mistake. On rare occasions, students may repeat behaviors or chronically display inappropriate choices over the course of time. We plan to use PARTy Days as a reteaching opportunity for these students that need more support. They will get to participate in our school-wide celebration, but we want to use part of the time to reinforce skills.

Our next PARTy Day will be Friday, April 27th from 1-2. Great job to our Millburn Mustangs for DOING THEIR PART!

For PICK UP, please pull in and find a parking spot. You can meet your child at the canopy area. You can also use the pick up lane, but if everyone does this, the line of traffic will stretch out to Route 45! No students will be allowed to walk or ride a bike home.
