<u>Parent Night on September 12th</u>: Thank you to everyone who came to Parent Night on Tuesday. I know a lot of information was presented, but we hope that you walked away with an overview of what your child will experience this year. <u>Attendance Week:</u> We had a great week of attendance. Our average this week was about 97%. We have submitted our attendance rate to the Lake County ROE and will wait to see if we made the top ten, or even better the top 5! Will we need to get the hair trimmers ready???

<u>Math Club</u>: Math Club will be starting on Monday, October 2nd. The purpose of the math club is to engage students in activities they most likely would not experience in their regular math class. There will opportunities for higher-level thinking problems, enrichment, and team problem solving.

<u>District Assessments</u>: As we begin the school year we take time to look at our students' skill levels. Different approaches are utilized in this process including the tool of assessment. The first assessment is the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP). This computer-based assessment is given to students in 2nd-8th grade in the areas of Reading and Math.

Another assessment we give is the STAR assessment in 1st-8th Grade. This is also computer-based and assesses Reading and Math. We take this assessment three times a year (Fall, Winter, Spring).

Finally, our Kindergarteners will be using the AIMSWeb assessment. This individualized assessment focuses on areas of early literacy and numeracy skills.

Although all three assessments provide achievement information on each child and enable us to measure growth, our primary purpose is to plan our instruction for the year. More information on these assessment can be found on our website: <u>https://www.millburn24.net/Page/4387</u>
