<u>iPAD Take Home Rights-</u> Students in grades 3rd-5th will be able to take iPADs home in the coming weeks. In order for students to have this option, parents must complete the following forms.

<u>Mustang Highlight:</u> We have a great staff at MES who do amazing things each and every day. At our monthly Staff Meetings, we recognize staff who have gone above and beyond through a Mustang Highlight. We would like to extend the opportunity to recognize our staff to our Millburn families. <u>District Assessments</u>: As we begin the school year we take time to look at our students' skill levels. Different approaches are utilized in this process including the tool of assessment. The first assessment is the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP). This computer-based assessment is given to students in 2nd-8th grade in the areas of Reading and Math.

Another assessment we give is the STAR assessment in 1st-8th Grade. This is also computer-based and assesses Reading and Math. We take this assessment three times a year (Fall, Winter, Spring).

Finally, our Kindergarteners will be using the AIMSWeb assessment. This individualized assessment focuses on areas of early literacy and numeracy skills.

Although all three assessments provide achievement information on each child and enable us to measure growth, our primary purpose is to plan our instruction for the year. More information on these assessment can be found on our website: <u>https://www.millburn24.net/Page/4387</u>

<u>How do I report my child's absence?</u> Our Attendance Line is available 24/7. Dial the building number and follow the prompt for the Attendance Line. The following information should be included in your message: your child's name, grade or homeroom, and the reason for the absence. NOTE: You must report the absence to the <u>school office</u>, not your child's teacher.

If a child's absence is unreported, the school will call contact numbers by 10:00 a.m.
