#### **Programming Updates**

The district is excited to be able to move forward with programming options! Please note – if you choose to move forward with inperson programming and the mitigation strategies change after the session has begun, the District will <u>NOT</u> be able to refund program fees if the program is able to be offered virtually.

As we head into spring/summer, here are a few things that you can expect from the Lindenhurst Park District staff in an effort to mitigate the spread of infectious diseases and keep participants and staff healthy:

- Reduced program participant capacities
- Different program drop off and pick up locations
- Limited spectators for programs
- Modification to the program to accommodate current guidelines
- Face mask will be required at all times while in the building and while participating in all youth activities indoors and out.

Here are the things our staff is doing to make sure you are safe at our programs:

- Increased sanitization of equipment and frequent cleaning of high touchpoints throughout the facility
- Required regular hand washing/sanitization for both staff and participants
- Individualized program supplies to avoid sharing and cross-contamination

Any participant exhibiting symptoms while participating in a program will be quarantined to a designated room until they can be picked up by a parent/guardian. The participant will be permitted to return to the program after all symptoms have subsided and an approved return-to-program note has been received by the district from your physician.

In the event of a confirmed case of COVID-19, participants will be notified immediately.

- The contaminated program space will be closed for cleaning for 24 hours after notification of exposure
- All program participants and staff will be required to self-quarantine for 14 days from the last date of exposure if they have had direct contact with the confirmed case

A participant can safely return to a program/facility after exposure or diagnosis of COVID-19 when:

- They have been fever-free for 72 hours without medicine
- ~ AND other symptoms have improved
- AND 10-14 days have passed since symptoms first appeared
- AND they have a return to participation notice from their physician

#### How Do I Pay?

Payments may be made by cash, check or charge. Checks should be made payable to the Lindenhurst Park District (\$25.00 service charge on all returned checks). We accept Visa, MasterCard, and Discover.

#### **Refund Policy**

Program refund requests (less a \$5 service charge for programs under \$99 or a \$10 service charge for programs over \$100) must be received at least seven 7 days before the start of a program. After that, refunds can only be given for medical reasons or relocation and will be pro-rated. When the district cancels programs due to low registration, full refunds will be given. Refund checks will be mailed within 14 days of the request. If registrations were paid by credit card, the charge account will be credited. Please note that refunds cannot be given for programs or trips that require advance admission or tickets, unless the district cancels them.

All residents will receive a 20% discount off listed prices with the exception of the Before & After School Program.

#### Are You R (resident) or NR (nonresident)?

Resident rates apply to those persons residing within the boundaries who contribute financial support to the Park District through property taxes. Those residents outside the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries are termed nonresidents-but are always welcome. The easiest way to check this is look at your county tax bill (check for Park District taxes paid). The Park District will ask for proof of residence.



#### How to Create a New Client Account

If you do not have an account, go to our website at www.lindenhurstparks.org.

- 1. Click on the Programs tab, then click on Register Now!
- 2. Go to the My Account tab in the upper right hand corner, and click Create an Account. Complete the fields. The account must belong to an adult 18 years or older.
- 3. You will receive an email confirmation your account was successfully created. This email must be validated to activate your account information.
- 4. Once activated, you can add family members and update any account information.

#### Log-in to an Existing Account
