- In order to register for camp, you may pay a \$50 non-refundable deposit or the full amount per child for each session at the time of registration to hold your spot.
 Session 5 requires the full payment at the time of registration.
- A \$25 late fee per child will be charged if final
 payments are not received by their due date. A late
 registration fee of \$25 will be added to registrations
 received within two weeks of the session starting.
 Your child may not attend camp until the full session

Payment Policy

Refunds

Refunds will be processed up 2 weeks prior to the start of a session. The \$50 deposit is non-refundable. No refunds will be given for partial attendance or for time spent in quarantine.

Vacation Proration

Attending camp after a vacation: it is recommended but not mandatory for children to quarantine before returning to camp. We ask that parents monitor everyone's health who traveled together prior to returning to camp. If anyone you traveled with is feeling sick or showing symptoms of COVID-19 the child will be required to quarantine before returning to camp.

Summer Camp Learn to Swim – ages 5-12

Camp Learn to Swim School is for participants from 5-12 years of age. Lessons are offered in conjunction with all full day and half day camps. Swim Instructors follow GPD Standards as campers progress through a variety of swimming and safety skills. A swim test will be given to any new participants on the first day of lessons to evaluate each childs ability and place them in the appropriate level. Parents must drop off their children at the Aquatic Center before each class. After lessons, children will be transported to their camp sites (cost included). (DD)

Swim Academy at the Aquatic Center – ages 6-15

- Experienced Swimmers: Swim strokes such as butterfly and sidestroke will be introduced, while simultaneously increasing distance and teaching lap lane etiquette.
- Advanced Swimmers: Focus on endurance, speed, diving, drills and starts. Enhance skills with practice sets and dryland exercises. Learn how to decrease swim times and improve stroke techniques. At the end of the session, skills will be showcased with a swim meet. (DD)
