INFORMATION/DISCUSSION

Remote Learning Update

In an attempt to assess any suggested changes or improvements Dr. Lind asked the community for feedback regarding how remote learning is going via ThoughtExchange. Dr. Lind shared some highlights with the board.

Of the 329 participants, there were 317 thoughts and, 11,440 ratings. Participants thought having a schedule is essential. Their biggest concern is the social and emotional aspect of remote learning. Lastly, teacher engagement and enthusiasm is very important with elementary school aged students. Top themes included Live Instruction Learning, Falling Behind, Child Learning, Class, Concerns with Social Interaction, Time, and Work to name a few.

Board Appointment Process

Denise Ide briefly explained the need to appoint someone to Carissa Casbon LaTourette's seat for the remainder of her term. The board will go into closed session tonight to review candidates who submitted their information and decide who to appoint at the next meeting in January, 2021.

District Phone System

The district has been in need of upgrading the phone systems. Last year before plans were finalized the quote received was too expensive once it was finalized. The district can do a request for proposal, interview new companies, or do both so that there are price comparisons. The phone system at the elementary school is 20 years old. The phone system at the middle school is 15 years old. Both systems need to be replaced. The district will begin looking for vendors after Winter Break.

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

Dr. Lind has been meeting with area Superintendents to talk about returning to school plans. They also meet with Lake County Health Department. The plan is to hold off on bringing students back into the buildings for two weeks after Winter Break at the Health Department's recommendation. January 19, 2021, would be the earliest Millburn's phase-in plan would start safely, beginning with the younger students like Millburn did in the fall.

Social and emotional support for staff members was a subject, more specifically how is the district supporting its staff members. Millburn continues to provide support to staff members. Staff members can complete a survey during the weekly check-in for support, there is an electronic communication called the Sunday Slice created by Kari Gedville for staff to share things like how their weekend went. Thursdays the district hosts district-wide STRONG meetings for staff. Staff members send notes to each other to connect and grow and generally encourage one another.
