Active Shooter/Emergency Management Plan

The principals meet every year with the local law enforcement agencies to review the emergency management plans for both schools. Each classroom has procedures for sheltering in place, locking down, reverse lock down (coming in from outside), and evacuation. Last year staff participated in ALICE training with the Lake County Sheriff's Department. ALICE stands for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate). ALICE training focuses on allowing teachers/adults to make decisions at the moment in the situation.
