A Public Hearing by the Board of Education of Millburn School District 24, Lake County, Illinois, held at Millburn Middle School, was called to order at 7:01 p.m. by President Robert Reding. Roll call was taken with the following Board Members in attendance: Diane Campbell, Jane Gattone, Scott Miller, Joseph Pineau, Robert Reding, Lisa Scanio and Chris Stream.

PUBLIC COMMENT - Robert Reding gave a short explanation of the levy process, then asked if there was anyone who wanted to speak regarding the proposed Levy for School Year 2012-13. There was no public comment. Dr. Stephen Johns said that the levy is advertised at \$11,811,901. He anticipates it to be certified at about \$11,330,000.

The Public Hearing remained open while the Board discussed other non-action items.

MEETING DATE CHANGE -- Supt. Jason Lind suggested changing the date of the next Committee of the Whole Meeting from Dec. 12 to Dec. 10 to avoid a conflict with a Band Concert. The Board agreed to change the Committee Meeting date to Monday, Dec.10. (The date change was announced again during the Regular Meeting that followed the Public Hearing.)

<u>FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS</u> -- Supt. Jason Lind reviewed future agenda items, one of which will be a discussion of fees. He will present data regarding registration, activity, bus and facilities use fees.

<u>BUSINESS REPORT</u> -- As part of the Business Report, Dr. Stephen Johns explained there will be an adjustment in the cash flow report to reflect three payrolls in November.

<u>CONFERENCE REPORTS</u> -- Supt. Jason Lind gave a report on the recent Tri-Conference in Chicago. He said it was an opportunity to discuss issues, such as the Common Core Standards, with other districts, and to learn more about financial issues at the state level. Supt. Lind and Robert Reding were part of a presentation on how to work with state legislators. Scott Miller represented Millburn as a voting delegate. Mr. Miller said he was one of 400 who voted on several resolutions.

Mr. Reding asked again if there was any public comment on the proposed levy. There was none.

A motion was made by Lisa Scanio and seconded by Diane Campbell to adjourn the Public Hearing. On a voice vote, all Board Members voted Aye. Nays: none. Absent: none. The motion passed.

The Public Hearing adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
