PUBLIC COMMENT – President Robert Reding asked if there was anyone who wanted to speak regarding the proposed Amended Budget for FY12. There was no public comment.


RECOGNITION – Supt. Jason Lind said he would like to use this time for public recognition, while the Public Hearing remained open.


