
A Public Hearing by the Board of Education of Millburn School District 24, Lake County, Illinois, held at Millburn Middle School, was called to order at 7 p.m. by President Jane Gattone. Roll call was taken with the following Board Members in attendance: Diane Campbell, Jane Gattone, Carissa LaTourette, Nichol Mangino, Trak Patel and Casandra Slade. Greg Ball was absent.

Supt. Jason Lind explained that the district is asking for a waiver from the state to allow school to be in session on three state holidays during the 2016-17 School Year: Veteran's Day, Lincoln's Birthday and Casimir Pulaski Day. He said the school calendar would be structured similar to the current school year. On Veterans Day, students will participate in activities and lessons that focus on the reason for Veterans Day. School will be in session on Lincoln's Birthday but not Presidents Day. Casimir Pulaski Day will continue to be a non-attendance day unless it is needed to make up for a snow day.

President Jane Gattone asked if there was any public comment. There was none.


