End of the Day Dismissal: At school we like to have system in place so that dismissal runs smoothly and that kids, parents and staff know how it works. Here are some reminders:

1. Parents are not allowed to pick up students from the bus loading area. You must arrange in advance with the office for alternate pick up plans. Do not try to pick up students from the bus loading area as this would be a security breach and will cause a difficult situation.

2. Remind students to get out to the bus asap at the end of the day. The bell rings at 3:02 and we want to send the busses by 3:10.

3. Parents are not allowed to enter the building at the East Entrance during dismissal. Please use the Main Entrance.

4. Student pick up is limited to our drive up lane and the Main Entrance parking lot. If you are parking, please get out and pick up your child from the Main Entrance canopy. You can also park and then wait until the pick up lane gets shorter.

5. Walkers need to leave school and report home promptly. They can come back to school around 4:15 for most after school sporting events.

6. Bikes, skateboards, roller blades need to be walked while on school grounds at drop off and pick up times due to the pedestrian and vehicle traffic.

Camp Timberlee: The 6^{th} grade class will be leaving on Monday and returning on Wednesday. This is a great trip that the 6^{th} grade teachers organize. It takes a ton of prep

work and on the site work. The reward is to see how much fun the kids have with each other at Camp Timberlee. Rest up over the weekend so you have energy for camp!

The directors will check the doors leading up to rehearsal and a final time right before rehearsal starts. Students that arrive late will be able to get into the building at the Main Entrance at 7:30 when the office opens.
