Our goal is to reduce discipline issues through the year and acknowledge students when they are following expectations. The intent of PBIS is to **focus our time on teaching and learning**. Here is a breakdown of one area of improvement over the last three years:

- 2012/2013 460 Student Referrals
- 2013/2014 415 Student Referrals
- 2014/2015 280 Student Referrals
