<u>School Lockdown Drills:</u> Each year, schools are required to practice emergency situation drills that include lockdowns. Recently, our school staff received training from the Lake County Police Department that was focused on protecting students in the event of an armed intruder.

Traditionally, our practice drills focused on locking classrooms and moving students out of sight. The next level of our drills will include giving students information on several possible actions to take.

- 1. Exiting the building to a safe location.
- 2. Barricading the classroom door to slow down an intruder.
- 3. Using classroom items in effort to slow, confuse and distract an intruder.

We are planning a practice drill for later this week. Our staff will be sharing these possible actions with the students during the drill.
