Emergency Drills: Today we practiced a couple emergency drills with students. We conducted a fire drill prior to taking students to MES for the 24 Hour Challenge. The fire department attended the drill to oversee the process. We do fire drills at least 3 times a year.

We also conducted a bus evacuation drill today. We bus the students to MES for the 24 Hour Challenge and we use this opportunity for our bus drivers to give students some directions on what to do in event they need to evacuate the bus. Exiting out the back door of the bus is practiced during these drills. Other emergency exit routes are shared with students.

Step 1: Log on to a browser of your choice

Step 2: Type in the following: ybpay.lifetouch.com

- Step 3: When prompted, put in the following code: 8478817 (Please be certain the you are in the correct Yearbook area. It should say Millburn Middle School in the upper left hand corner)
- Step 4: When prompted, enter your child's first name, last name, and grade level
- Step 5: The next page gives you the opportunity to order as many copies as you would like. Each copy will be \$25.00.
- Step 6: The next page is where you will supply your billing information.
- Step 7: Submit your order

At this time, you can print your receipt. If however, you should misplace your receipt, or you just don't remember if you placed an order, you can always come back to check on your order.
