A Committee of the Whole Meeting of the Board of Education of Millburn School District 24, Lake County, Illinois, held at Millburn Central School, was called to order at 7 p.m. by President Robert Buehler. <u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u> – Carla Blanchard thanked all the Board Members for volunteering their time to serve on the Board. She also wished good luck to all the candidates running in School Board elections taking place April 5.

INFORMATION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

<u>AMENDED SCHOOL CALENDAR</u> – Dr. Ellen Mauer explained that the district must submit an amended calendar to the regional office and the state because of the two days school was canceled for inclement weather. The amended 2010-11 Calendar adds two attendance days to the end of the year, which makes the last day of school June 7, 2011. The amended calendar will be on the Consent Agenda for approval at the next Regular Board Meeting.

<u>ENERGY AUDIT</u> – The Board agreed to table discussion on a proposed Energy Audit. The topic will be added to the next Regular Board Meeting agenda.
