Subject: Special Services Report

Last week the State Board of Education put out its preliminary 2008-2009 Illinois Special Education Profile report. This profile allows school districts to see their total percentages of special education students both overall, and separately in each of the 14 disability categories. It also allows us to compare our percentages with all other elementary districts in the state, in addition to the total state averages.

As in recent years, Millburn's total percentage of special education students (15.1%) is almost exactly the same as the average of all elementary districts (15.3%), as well as with the state average (14.8%). Attached is a copy of the complete profile for Millburn CCSD 24 for your information.
