

Your child will not be allowed to start school without the required physical and immunizations. Students who do not meet these requirements will be excluded from the first day of school until these requirements are met.

Dear Parents/Guardians:

You are receiving this notice because you have a child in or entering one of the grades listed. The State of Illinois requires the following for all students entering **Early Childhood (ECH)**,

Kindergarten (K), Sixth Grade or transferring in from any grade from out-of-state for the current school year.

- 1. A physical examination by a licensed physician can be dated up to one year preceding entrance to Millburn School District. A form is attached.
- 2. A sports physical is NOT ACCEPTABLE as a substitute for this state required physical examination.
- 3. Immunizations must be up to date as follows:

→ THE PHYSICAL FORM IS ALSO AVAILABLE ON THE WEBSITE. IT IS THE ONLY ONE ACCEPTED BY THE STATE OF ILLINOIS FOR THE PHYSICAL EXAMINATION.

• Fill out the medical history and the complete immunization dates (month, day, and year) before your physician fills out his portion of the form. Return the completed form to the school after your child's physical date. It is not necessary to wait to include it with any other registration forms.

HELPFUL SUGGESTIONS:

- (1) make a copy for your records prior to turning in the physical exam
- (2) if making a summer appointment, make it early as these appointments fill up fast
- Immunizations may be given by your family physician or by the Lake County Health Department (call 847 360-6761 for an appointment). If you have any questions, please call the school's Health Office.
- If your child's immunizations are not up to date because of a medical reason, it must be verified in writing by your physician. This written notification must be turned in with the other health forms.
- The physical examination form is being sent home now so that an appointment may be made early with your family physician to avoid the last minute rush.
- The physical and completed immunization form are due to the Health Office by the first week of August.

TWO ITEMS OF SPECIAL NOTE

- (1) If your child's date of physical falls after the first week of August please notify the Health Office at your child's school so this information can be documented.
- (2) If your child is in middle school and will be participating in a late spring sport, the physical should be dated <u>after</u> the first week of June so your child will be covered for the season.

Your child **cannot** be on a class list if completed physical exam is not received.

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
