The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education of Millburn School District 24, Lake County, Illinois, held at Millburn Central School, was called to order at 7 p.m. by President Robert Reding. Roll call was taken with the following Board Members in attendance: Diane Campbell, Jane Gattone, Scott Miller, Joseph Pineau and Robert Reding. Lisa Scanio and Chris Stream were absent.

<u>PUBLIC COMMENT</u> – Kim Dodd said she has been hearing from several people about the district still being over budget. She asked if an administrator would phone or email her with information about the budget.

<u>ADDITION OF NON-ACTION ITEMS</u> – Dave Bending, president of the Millburn Education Foundation, gave an update to the Board on the Foundation's recent activities. He explained that the foundation is a non-profit organization whose mission is to enrich the learning experience by enhancing Millburn School District's resources. In its five years of

existence, the foundation has raised \$40,000 to \$70,000 a year. Expenses are about 30-44 percent of revenue. Mr. Bending said the foundation has seen a decline in its ability to raise funds the last few years. A recent focus has been to improve "brand recognition." The foundation wants to be recognized as a separate Millburn entity, not to be confused with the Board of Education or the PTOs. A main goal for this year is to launch a capital campaign that will help the district fulfill its Strategic Plan. Other goals include writing grants; refreshing the main fundraiser, March Madness; and balancing the distribution of funds across all grade levels. In the past, the foundation has funded annual college scholarships to Millburn graduates, helped finance the 8<sup>th</sup> grade trip to Springfield and the 6<sup>th</sup> grade trip to Camp Timberlee, and help pay expenses for other school projects.

ACTIVITY ACCOUNTS – Joseph Pineau asked about a \$3,360 transfer of funds from the Millburn West to the Millburn Central account. Jake Jorgenson explained that this was money raised during the 24-Hour Challenge that was deposited in the West account, but should have been deposited in Central's. K-8/GRADE LEVEL CENTERS - Board Members spoke individually to express their thoughts on the topic of grade level configuration for the schools next year, specifically whether the district schools should remain K-8 buildings, or switch to grade level centers. Each of the six Board Members present at the meeting said they were planning to vote for grade level centers. The Board continued to discuss the issue after the individual statements. Discussion topics included:

- Current enrollment numbers at each school
- Outlook for state funding
- Providing the best possible education for all students
- · Meetings and discussions on this topic over the past few years
- · Opinions expressed by school administration and staff
- Financial ramifications
- Research presented by the district committee
- Inequities in class sizes
- Uniting the district
- Repetition of services
- Ability to reach future goals
- Unique character of Millburn School District
- Process followed to research the topic and present information
- Using all district assets equitably and efficiently
- Future evaluation of changes
- Home values and the housing market
- Student achievement
- Successfully making the transition

The Board said it will take a formal vote on the issue at the Regular Meeting of Jan. 18.

<u>ISAT COHORT STUDY</u> – Dr. Cheryl Kucera presented the ISAT Cohort Study 2011. She discussed the ISAT Exceeds standard, Millburn Meets/Exceeds statistics, the concept of grade level cohorts, and cohort data. She discussed how this information can be used when determining the number of students moving from the Meets to the Exceeds category. The presentation is posted on the district website.

<u>BUS LEASE</u> – Supt. Jason Lind reported that he and Dr. Stephen Johns are reviewing the current bus lease and preparing to seek bids for next year's service. The Board discussed the timeline for the bid process, the length of the lease, and other items that might be addressed in the bid.

<u>FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS</u> – Topics that will be addressed at upcoming meetings include: Grade Level Configuration; Millburn Before and Afterschool Care Program; Kindergarten Enrichment Program; Proposed 2012-13 Calendar; Review of Closed Session Minutes; and the Prevailing Wage Ordinance.
