Subject: Special Services Report

The Special Education District of Lake County (SEDOL) contracted with the ECCRA Group to do some analyses of trends (2006-2008) for students with disabilities from amongst its 36 member districts. The attached table 1 (pgs 1-2) presents the data for overall student performance (sorted by the gap in ISAT performance between students with IEP's and students without). The attached table 2 (pgs 3-4) presents data for percentage of time in the general education vs. in special education for students with IEP's.

When looking at the gap analyses for overall student performance, each year we have been able to increase special education student performance while simultaneously decreasing the gap between their performance compared with their non-disabled Millburn peers.

When looking at Least Restrictive Environment (LRE), that is, the percentage of students who spend the majority of their time in a general education setting, Millburn continues to do well. 2008 data show that Millburn had the lowest percentage of special education students who were educated in a separate setting altogether (0.5%).

The following table presents the overall percentages of state test scores considered proficient or above. This combines all subjects for all grades tested for the following tests: the **Illinois Standards Achievement Test** (ISAT) for students in grades 3 through 8; the **Prairie State Achievement Examination** (PSAE) for students in grade 11; the **Illinois Measure of Annual Growth in English** (IMAGE) for students who are unable to take the ISAT or PSAE due to their lack of proficiency in English; and the **Illinois Alternate Assessment** (IAA) for students with disabilities whose Individual Education Programs (IEPs) indicate that participation in the ISAT or PSAE would not be appropriate.
