# **Business Office Update January 9, 2017 Meeting**

#### **FOIA**

- The district received a FOIA request from the Lake County News-Sun requesting
  - Enrollment numbers for this school year and the preceding four school years of students classified as homeless, broken down by whether the district is the students' district of origin or not:
  - Data showing how much the district has spent on transporting homeless students, what school district the transportation has been to/from, what type of transportation was provided (school bus, taxi, etc.), and over what period of time the transportation was provided for school years 2012-13 through 2015-16;
  - Budget records showing services provided to homeless students, i.e. district liaison for homeless families; and
  - Job description for employee who performs duties of district liaison.
- The district also received a FOIA request from SmartProcure. We are not currently able to provide all of the detail requested because we cannot pull this information from our current financial software. We are able to provide everything except the line item details, line item quantity, and line item price. The FOIA requested the following information from beginning September 2, 2016:
  - Purchase order number. If purchase orders are not used a comparable substitute is acceptable, i.e., invoice, encumbrance, or check number
  - Purchase date
  - Line item details (Detailed description of the purchase)
  - o Line item quantity
  - o Line item price
  - o Vendor ID number, name, address, contact person and their email address
  - o What is the beginning of your fiscal year?

# **Summer 2016 & Future Projects**

- Attached is a sheet showing the Summer 2016 projects completed and future projects to be completed.
- In reviewing the projects completed this past year, I am amazed at the large number of projects that we have been able to complete in-house with the talents of our staff. While we typically bid out the larger projects, the projects that we can do in-house result in significant savings to the district.
- I will soon be asking the administrative staff to suggest projects for summer 2017 and beyond that will result in a longer list.
- We currently have \$332,630 in the Capital Projects Fund. I'm anticipating revenue of approximately \$55,000 from the lighting project that would bring out total funds available to approximately \$388,000 for future projects.
- Unless some other emergency situation arises, we should be able to fund most of the projects that have been identified thus far.
- The life safety projects identified can be funded from the Life Safety Fund and the funds will be available using the tax revenue received in the 2016-17 and 2017-18 school year.
- I will be meeting with Fanning Howey later this week to begin the process of bidding out the major projects for Summer, 2017. The current schedule would have the bids going out in late March, 2017. The bids would tentatively be awarded at the April 24, 2017 Board of Education meeting.

# **Insurance Reimbursement**

• The district received \$212,615.94 from the insurance company for the chiller replacement.

# Financial & Human Resource Software

- We have met with three software vendors and have narrowed the search to two vendors.
- The next step will be to do a comparison of the features of each of the two software packages as well as to talk to school district personnel that currently use the software.
- The goal is to make a decision by late January or early February so that we can complete the migration to the new software by June 30, 2017 when support for DCR ends.
