Chiller Update

- The new chiller was put in place on October 20, 2016.
- Since that time, Grubbs Mechanical has been hooking up piping, wiring, HVAC controls, etc...
- The startup of the chiller was scheduled for October 19, 2016. This will include a representative from Trane, the low voltage electrician, and Grubbs Mechanical staff. I'll update you on the startup when we meet on Monday.
- The total cost of the chiller came in at less than the \$235,000 that the board approved as a maximum. The total cost is \$223,352. We will also be receiving approximately \$800 for the copper and steel that was salvaged from the old chiller.
- I am still in contact with the insurance company regarding our claim for reimbursement. I am hopeful that the claim will be approved.

Bus Accident

- One of our buses was rear-ended on October 5, 2016 in Mundelein. The bus was only going 2-3 miles per hour when the accident occurred in the construction zone of the Route 45 construction.
- We are in the process of obtaining an estimate for our insurance company. The only damage to our bus was the bumper.

Property Tax Levy

- The first reading of the 2016 Property Tax Levy will be held on November 14, 2016.
- A complete calendar of the 2016 Property Tax Levy dates is attached.

EIS Administrator and Teacher Salary and Benefits Report

• Each year, we are required to present the Teacher and Salary Benefits Report to the Board of Education at a regularly scheduled meeting. This requires no action on the part of the board.

TFT-LCD Screen Settlement

- The Illinois Attorney General entered into a settlement agreement with manufacturers of "thin-film transistor liquid-crystal displays." The total settlement dollars available are \$104.6 million.
- The settlement covers any flat panel displays purchased by the district from January 1, 1998 through December 31, 2006
- The district submitted a claim for 92 notebook computers and 119 flat panel displays. The maximum the district will receive from this settlement is \$39,575. If more claims are made than can be funded, the payout will be pro-rated.

FOIA

• The district received a Freedom of Information Request from the Illinois Education Association requesting information on the district's non-certified employees.

Activities

- I attended the Volcano meetings at Hawthorn Elementary District on September 30, 2016. The group discussed the various surveys that it would conduct during the 2016-17 school year.
