<u>PARCC</u>: We are still a few months off, but the state assessment, PARCC, will be administered to students in grades 3rd-5th when we get back from Spring Break. Last year, the PARCC was broken down into two parts: five tests given in March (Performance Tests), three more in May (End of the Year Tests). This year the state changed the PARCC so that students take fewer tests and they occur within a week's time. Therefore, students will be taking 7 tests total (4 Math, 3 English/Language Arts). We are still planning the structure of those days, but we are looking at students taking one test per day. Therefore, a total of seven days of PARCC testing at MES, roughly Between March 29th and April 8th. We will keep you updated on these assessments and the timeframes that will occur.
