Also, please review the content of applications before students use them to assure all content is appropriate for their viewing. Do some research into it by reading reviews and blogs. One great site to use for finding out such information is www.commonsensemedia.org. This site provides a variety of information to help students "thrive in a world of media and technology."

There are many applications out there: some good, some bad. Please take the time and choose the best ones for your child before downloading them.
