Proof of Residency: Parents do not need to come in to prove residency this year. However, if you are not the owner of the home you live in, contact the school office to update your residency information.

Homeroom Assignments/ Bus Routes: Homerooms will be sent on Tuesday, August 18. You will not only get to find out who the homeroom teacher is, but also see the class roster. If you do not get an email, please contact the office. I will also include a link of all the bus routes. This link is only available to Millburn parents who receive the email.

Supply Pick Up: If you didn't get a chance to pick up your pre-ordered supply kits, you are welcome to visit the main office to pick up your kit between the hours of 8-12 on weekdays.

Picture Forms: Color Portraits Picture order form are in the Virtual Backpack. You can pay for your pictures in advance following directions on the form or you can bring payment and order form with you on the day of pictures. We will also have available copies for parents at Supply Pick up on August 11.

Kindergarten Parent Night: This night is designed for parents to get familiar with our school and programming for their Kindergarten child. That night will feature some information on procedures, bussing, and the curriculum that will be used during the course of the school year. This evening of presentations is structured for parents only. Students will have a chance to meet with teachers at Supply Drop Off Night on August 26.

School Pictures/Supply Drop Off/ PTO Ice Cream Social: On August 26th we invite families to come to MES to drop supplies off in classrooms, get school pictures taken and enjoy a PTO Ice Cream Social. All events start at 3:30 and run until 6pm. Pictures will be in the East and West Gyms and the PTO will be set up in the Cafeteria. We will open doors to the building at 3:30 and you can choose what event you and your child would like to do first. Student last names from A-L will take their picture in the East Gym. Last names from M-Z will be in the West Gym.

1st-5th Parent Night: Parent Night (Formerly Curriculum Night) at MES will be Thursday, September 10. Grades 1-3 will start at 6:00 PM and Grades 4- 5 will start at 7:00 PM. This night is designed to help inform parents of our curriculum and our goals to provide high quality instruction for our students. Special Area teachers will be available in their rooms if you would like to stop by and talk with them. This night is for parents only. Once again, parents are asked to report directly to their child's homeroom at their assigned time.

Immunizations: Parents or legal guardians who object, for religious reasons, to their child being immunized for school entrance must submit a Certificate of Religious Exemption, which now must be signed by a health care provider. Signed into law on August 3, 2015, this new legislation requires a health care provider to sign the certificate confirming they have provided education to parents or legal guardians about the benefits of immunizations and the health risks of not vaccinating students. The certificate also reflects the parents or legal guardians understanding that their child may be excluded from school in the case of a vaccine-preventable disease outbreak or exposure. This new requirement will be in place for religious exemption requests beginning October 16, 2015. If you have any questions, please contact Ms. Vanko, our school nurse.
