Mustang Minute: September 18, 2015

<u>Student Achievement</u>: Each year, students in grades 2nd-5th at Millburn Elementary take the NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) in the areas of math and reading. This computer-based assessment is done twice a year (Fall, Spring). We use these assessments to not only see how many students are proficient in these areas, but most importantly, to show student growth. Most of our students saw tremendous growth last year! In Reading, we went from 82% of students proficient, to 85%. In Math, we grew from 81% to 85%. We continue to move onward in seeing success for all students and look forward to seeing these numbers only get higher.

This year's MAP testing begins next week for students in grades 2nd-5th grade.

<u>2nd Step Program</u>: Millburn Elementary students are taught weekly lessons on social-emotional skills. Social-emotional skills—like math skills—build on each other. We use the 2nd Step program to teach these skills. The program is designed to educate children how to understand and manage their emotions, control their reactions, be aware of others' feelings, and have the skills to problem-solve and make responsible decisions. These lessons are taught weekly on Wednesday mornings in all classrooms.

Student Pick Up: We are starting a new procedure with parents picking up their child at the end of the school day. <u>School Access After Hours</u>: If your child forgot something in their classrooms at the end of the day, you will need to come to the school before 3:00. Parents cannot access the building through the Millburn Before and After School Club entrance. Those doors are strictly for parents picking up their child from the program. Thank you for your cooperation.

Book Challenge: We will once again hold our Book Challenge this year. Last year we reached 15,000 books read, so we need to go over 15,0000 books this year. We need everyone's help with this. <u>Math Challenge</u>: We are also looking at a math challenge as well this school year. More information will come in the next few weeks, but this challenge will involve families working together to complete math challenges, which will be available twice a month.

<u>Immunizations</u>: Parents or legal guardians who object, for religious reasons, to their child being immunized for school entrance must submit a Certificate of Religious Exemption, which now must be signed by a health care provider. Signed into law on August 3, 2015, this new legislation requires a health care provider to sign the certificate confirming they have provided education to parents or legal guardians about the benefits of immunizations and the health risks of not vaccinating students. The certificate also reflects the parents or legal guardians understanding that their child may be excluded from school in the case of a vaccine-

preventable disease outbreak or exposure. This new requirement will be in place for religious exemption requests beginning October 16, 2015. If you have any questions, please contact Ms. Vanko, our school nurse.
