<u>Math Challenge</u>: We will also start our Math Challenge next week. For each challenge, we will direct you to a link to view the math challenge. Challenges will be every other week. Students work with their families to solve math problems, but each student in the family needs to submit challenges separately. To track the challenges, students will need to submit their answers to a link, similar to our Reading Challenge. Our goal is to get 5000 submissions by the end of the school year. <u>Student Pick Up:</u> We are starting a new procedure with parents picking up their child at the end of the school day. First, we will be dismissing students by grade level starting with KDG and moving up from there. Older siblings will sit with their younger siblings and will be released together. Parents will be called up by grade to sign their child out. We appreciate everyone's flexibility and patience so we can assure students go home safely.

<u>School Access After Hours:</u> If your child forgot something in their classrooms at the end of the day, you will need to come to the school before 3:00. Parents cannot access the building through the Millburn Before and After School Club entrance. Those doors are strictly for parents picking up their child from the program. Thank you for your cooperation.

Recess Volunteers: Millburn Elementary School is looking for volunteers to assist on the playgrounds during this 2015-2016 academic year. Recess volunteers are needed Monday-Friday between 11AM-1215PM. Recess volunteers can sign up for one day a week, one day every other week or even one day each month. Kindergarten parents are also asked to go through this process if you wish to volunteer for recess. <u>Immunizations:</u> Parents or legal guardians who object, for religious reasons, to their child being immunized for school entrance must submit a Certificate of Religious Exemption, which now must be signed by a health care provider. Signed into law on August 3, 2015, this new legislation requires a health care provider to sign the certificate confirming they have provided education to parents or legal guardians about the benefits of immunizations and the health risks of not vaccinating students. The certificate also reflects the parents or

legal guardians understanding that their child may be excluded from school in the case of a vaccine-preventable disease outbreak or exposure. This new requirement will be in place for religious exemption requests beginning October 16, 2015. If you have any questions, please contact Ms. Vanko, our school nurse.
