Mustang Minute: April 21, 2017

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<u>NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP)</u>: Starting next week, students in grades 2nd- 5th will take a Math and Reading MAP assessment. This is our local assessment that we use to measure progress in these academic areas. It is an adaptive test, which means that the next question of the test depends on how they answered the previous question. Therefore, the test adapts to the student so we can pinpoint their level of achievement. We will include a report of these test in the end of the year report card envelope. As always, if you have any questions about your child's progress, contact your child's teacher.

<u>Fire Drill:</u> We conducted a surprise Fire Drill on Thursday. The staff and students did a great job! We were able to evacuate and account for all students in a good time.

<u>Lockdown Drill:</u> Last month, we conducted our traditional lockdown drill. This drill is used in the event an intruder enters the building. Earlier this year, Our staff was trained in new strategies from the Lake County Sheriff's Department when it comes to intruders. Traditionally, we have had students hide in the corner of their classrooms, out of sight from the doorway. To add to this, it is recommended that students also have items in their hands to throw, in the event that an intruder enters the room. This distracts the intruder and students can then attempt to exit the room.

Next Friday, we will be showing students this new strategy. Teachers will be discussing what objects they could choose within the classroom. We will then do another lockdown drill using this new strategy. We will not be simulating an intruder entering the room, but we want students to practice finding an object in the room when a lockdown is called.
