<u>Lockdown Drill:</u> As I mentioned last week, today we taught students a new strategy in our lockdown drill. With recommendation from the Lake County Sheriff's Department, we are now having students grab items to throw, in the event that an intruder enters the room. This distracts the intruder and students can then attempt to exit the room. Teachers discussed items within the room students could use to throw. We then did a lockdown drill with the Lindenhurst Police Department and students practiced grabbing items and going into the corner of the room. We did not simulate an intruder coming in, but wanted stdunest to practice getting an object to throw. Students did a great job.
