Love and Logic Pearls: How do you handle a child who talks back, or what to say when you hear from your child "I'm bored." Heck, being a parent is a tough thing and not everyone knows every answer. Each week we will be sharing some useful strategies for parents, using the Love and Logic approach. Love and Logic is a approach we have adopted as a school, which is founded by Jim Fay and Foster Cline.

"Children learn the best lessons when they're given a task and allowed to make their own choices(and fail) when the cost of the failure is still small. Children's failures must be coupled with love and empathy from their parents and teachers."

Each week we will be including some helpful and useful approaches for parents as they go through the challenegs of raising their children. This week's edition is dealing with that child who keeps talking back to you. I think we've all been there!

**Bus Safety Tip:** On occasion, we will share a bus safety tip for you to reinforce with your child. This week's tip: Always cross in front of the bus when arriving or departing the bus. That way the bus driver can see students and knows when they are safely off the roadway and the bus can proceed with the route. SWe have been seeing students walking around the back of the bus in the back and this makes it difficult for our drivers to assure student safety.

<u>Autism Awareness</u>: April is National Autism Awareness Month. Next Wednesday, we will be proving lessons to students on autism. Thousands of individuals, including many at Millburn, have autism. We find it important to educate our students on what autism is and how an individual with autisms experiences our world today. We are asking for students to wear as much blue as they can next Wednesday to show support for autism awareness. Classrooms will count up how many pieces of blue they are wearing and the winning class at each grade with win a prize!

## PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Support):

Before we left from Spring Break, we had an assembly to celebrate with our students the great choices they have been making this year with their behavior. I walked them through some numbers, showing where we see behaviors taking place, when, and even the time of day. The most powerful piece I shared was that 75% of our students have never received a minor or a major: that is 556 students! That number is amazing and we celebrated that with our students. Although our school year is not done, we want o keep that number as high as we can and the only way to do that is to continue to make great choices.

<u>2017-2018 Class Placements</u>: We are currently in the process of planning and placing students into homerooms for next year. Please find a letter in the Virtual Backpack with some information on how this process works. As a reminder, <u>class lists WILL NOT be sent via email over the summer</u>. Parents will need to log into PowerSchool to see their child's homeroom teacher once it goes live in August. Parents are encouraged to set up their accounts ASAP so to access before the next school year begins. If you need assistance with getting your account set-up, please contact our main office.
