<u>PTO UPDATE!!</u> Thanks to all who attended our last PTO meeting of the year! Sharing ideas and getting feedback is priceless and adds to the success of our PTO.

We approved the PTO purchase of a RAPTOR TECHNOLOGIES VISITOR MANAGEMENT SYSTEM for both schools that will be set up over the summer. This technology system will replace ineffective sign-in sheets with the RAPTOR system that is designed to protect students, faculty, and staff. Every visitor, volunteer, and vendor will be instantly screened through a database by scanning their driver's license. Custom settings can be set up for custodial alerts, banned visitors and other custom alerts. The RAPTOR system ensures accurate records are kept for every visitor and reports can generate a list of who is in the building instantly. THANK YOU to all families who have supported the PTO this past year in any of our fundraising so that we were able purchase the nation's leading developer of integrated safety technologies for K-12 schools!

We successfully passed an amendment to our By-Laws changing our Board to (1) MES President, (1) MMS President, (1) Vice President, (1) Treasurer and (1) Secretary.
