The Millburn PTO Board would like to thank our members and Millburn school community for another successful school year.

- PTO approved over \$10,688 in funds throughout the school year for <u>Special Requests</u> including new color & black/white art printers, Zoo admission for EC, Speech/EC supplies, a new Greg Tang Math Kit program, Smart TV & playground bench for MES, playground canopy & water bottle filler for MMS, and a new Raptor Visitor ID system.
