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<u>PBIS</u>: Positive Behavior, Interventions and Supports is a way for us to promote positive behavior with our students during the course of the school year. We want to limit the inappropriate behaviors in order to maximize learning. We do a variety of acknowledgments during the year to showcase positive behavior and celebrate our accomplishments. We are in continual communication with students as to where we need to focus our attention.

Last year we decreased the number of inappropriate behaviors by 30 incidents. We want to build on that momentum and keep students motivated to make the right choices.

Some changes have been made to our program this year that we hope will continue this trend. Three times a year students will have celebration days, which we call **PART**y (Do Your Part) Days. On those days, students will get to participate in fun activities in different classrooms within their grade level. They might involve having a movie room, game room, arts 'n' crafts room, and other fun activities we find for our students.

We will have a handful of assemblies during the year that will resemble our traditional PBIS assemblies involving celebrations, skits, and fun times.

Students of the Month will continue. When students get this award their name will be announced on the morning announcements, they will have their pictures taken and displayed in the hallway for the month, and parents will be invited to either take their child to lunch or have lunch with their child.

We will also continue our Bus Star awards, weekly raffles, and Students of the Week.
