<u>MAP Testing</u>: We will be conducting our fall MAP testing starting next week for our 2nd-5th Graders. MAP testing is a computer-adaptive assessment that assists us in identifying where students are at with their learning. There are two assessments: one assessment for reading, another for math. Depending on how they answer the question determines the level of difficulty in the next question. Students will head to one of our computer labs and take their assessment on two different days. Since it is an adaptive test, students may take up to an hour to complete their assessment.

These assessments are conducted twice a year, first in the Fall and then in the Spring. Reports will be sent home in report cards later in the year which will highlight their score and how it compares to similar students at Millburn and nationally. If you have any questions about the assessment, please contact your child's teacher or Mr. Walshire.

<u>Absence Calls:</u> Next week, we will begin to use our SchoolMessenger system to notify parents of unreported absences. Parents will receive both an email and a phone call if their child's absence has not been reported by 9:00. Parents will be asked to contact the school immediately with the reason for the absence.
