Four seats on the Millburn C. C. School District 24 Board of Education will be up for election in the consolidated election on April 5, 2011. The vacancies are for three (3) four-year terms of office and one (1) two-year unexpired term. The candidates will be elected into office on April 5, 2011. The vacancies are open to any individual meeting the criteria. A candidate must be:

- a citizen of the United States
- 18 years of age or over on the date of the election
- a resident of the State of Illinois and District 24 for at least one year immediately preceding the election
- a registered voter

Nominating petition packets are available beginning Tuesday, September 21 in the district office at 640 Freedom Way, Lindenhurst. The office hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Prospective candidates should be aware of the following important dates:

- December 13 - first day to file nominating papers with the District Election official.
- December 20 - last day to file nominating papers with the District Election official

District residents are encouraged to run for the school board and take part in the education of District 24 students. Individuals who are seeking election are encouraged to attend board meetings now, which are held on the third Monday of every month, as well as other District activities, to become familiar with the school and staff.
