NONE of the samples taken at Millburn Elementary School exceeded the acceptable levels for copper and lead.

All of the lead results were within acceptable limits. All of the tests showed lead levels of less than 0.0020 mg/L. Levels at or less than 0.015 mg/L are considered acceptable.

All of the copper tests were within acceptable limits. Four of the copper tests showed copper levels at <0.150 mg/L with one test showing a level of 0.260 mg/L. Levels at or below 1.3 mg/L are acceptable for copper.
