## **NEW CONSTRUCTION**

- At this point, I am aware of approximately \$200,000 Equalized Assessed Value (EAV) in new construction that will be included when the EAV is certified in the Spring.
- New construction falls outside the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (PTELL) and allows the district to increase their levy by the taxes generated by new construction
- Each \$100,000 EAV in new construction will increase the district's levy by approximately \$4,000.

- The levy is anticipated to be certified at approximately \$11,330,000

### Notice of Proposed Property Tax Levy for Millburn C.C. School District 24 Lake County, Illinois

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy for Millburn C.C. School District 24, Lake County, Illinois, for 2012 will be held on Wednesday, November 28, 2012, at 7:00 p.m. at the Millburn Middle School, Learning Resource Center, 640 Freedom Way, Lindenhurst, Illinois 60046.

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2011 were \$8,887,265.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2012 are \$9,651,901. This represents An 8.60% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2011 were \$2,063,206.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2012 are \$2,160,000. This represents a 4.69% increase over the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2011 were \$10,950,471.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2012 are \$11,811,901. This represents a 7.87% increase over the previous year.
