## Kinder Readiness Committee

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- Convened by State Superintendent Koch
- Charge examine the feasibility of a uniform, statewide kindergarten readiness process



### Kinder Readiness Committee

#### • Goals of Process

- Promote the success of every child
- Guide professional development
- Support the alignment of early childhood and elementary school systems
- Document the important role that early childhood programs play in preparing children for elementary school

# **KIDS** Process

#### • What is KIDS?

- Observation-based assessment
- Conducted three times during the kindergarten year
- Occurs within context of typically occurring activities in the classroom
- Across multiple developmental domains




## **KIDS** Implementation Timeline

2012-2013 5000 Kindergarten Students
2013-2014 10,000 Kindergarten Students
2014-2015 30,000 Kindergarten Students
2015-2016 Statewide Implementation

# Assessing Our Students

• The assessment of young children should **promote** learning, not simply measure it.



## Our Proposal

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- KIDS Assessment will be implemented in 2015-2016
- In our current half-day program, the rigorous KIDS assessment will replace significant teacher direct instruction time
- With a strong curriculum, dedicated teachers, as well as available space, we are proposing full-day kindergarten for the 2014-2015 school year

# Our Proposal

- The benefits of full-day kindergarten are numerous
  - Academic/Social Impact

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- Curriculum Implications
- Minimal Adjustments to our current program

 Teachers have more time to get to know their children and individualize their instruction, while giving children sufficient time to complete an increasingly rigorous

Curriculum (National Center)



Full-day students spend more time in child-initiated activities, with teachers citing benefits of flexibility, child-initiated creative activities and less student stress (Elicker)

 Continuity for children accustomed to full-day experiences, reduces the number of disruptions and transitions, allows for more formal

and informal instruction

(Kauerz.)



 Easier transition to first grade, stronger learning skills, leads to higher academic achievement, improves student attendance, supports literacy and language development. (West End)



## **Curriculum Implications**

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 More time can be devoted to cooperative small group work, child-initiated discovery based activities and more small-group instruction (West End)

## **Curriculum Implications**

 Full-day classes have the ability to spend time everyday on reading, writing, math, social studies, and science (National Center)

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### **Curriculum Implications**

• Teachers find they have more time for curriculum planning; they are able to incorporate a greater number of thematic units that offered more in-depth COVERAGE (Elicker)

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- 2 Full Time Teachers
- 2 Full Time Paraprofessionals
  - Reallocate SPED Paraprofessionals to Kindergarten Paraprofessionals

## Our Full Day Vision

- Kindergarten Paraprofessional Position
  - Currently on staff
  - Trained to work with small groups
  - Team with kindergarten teacher to gather data for KIDS Assessment
  - Provide lunch/recess supervision
