## Reading Strategies for Unknown Words

- 1. Skip the difficult word.
- 2. Read on to the end of the sentence or paragraph. Go back to the beginning of the sentence and try again.
- 3. Read on. Reread inserting the beginning sounds of the unknown word.
- 4. Substitute a word that makes sense.
- 5. Look for a known chunk or small word.
- 6. Use your finger to cover up part of the word.
- 7. Look at the pictures for clues.
- 8. Read a word using only the beginning and ending sounds.
- 9. read the word without the vowels.
- 10. Predict and anticipate what could come next.
- 11. Cross check

"Poes it sound right?"

"Does it make sense?"

"Poes it look right?"

- 12. Self correct and self monitor
- 13. Write words you can't figure out and need to know on

Post-its.

14. Read a passage several times for fluency and meaning. Use errors as an opportunity to problem solve.
